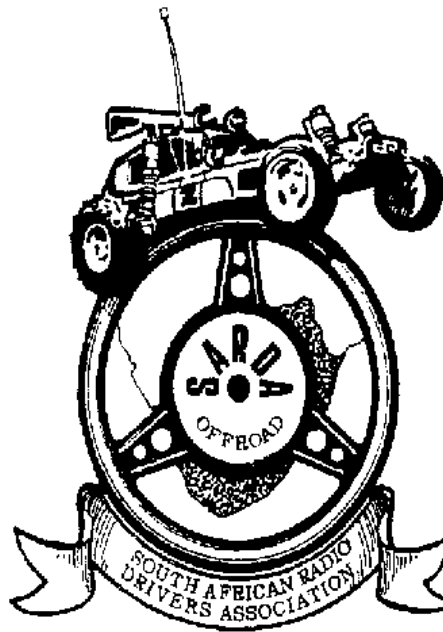

4. RACE ORGANIZATION

- This race will follow SARDA Off-Road Electric Rules 2016 Version 1, these rules can be found on the SARDA website at www.sarda.org.za
- 2wd Stock & 4wd Stock will be run in "blinky" mode, thus 0° timing
- 2wd Stadium Stock will run 17.5t boosted.

4.1 CONTROLLED TYRES

The classes and tires that will be regulated are as follows:

- 2WD Stock Rear Tires
- 2WD Mod Rear Tires
- 4WD Stock Front & Rear Tires
- 4wd Mod Front and rear Tires.

Tire make and model: **Proline Holeshoot M3**

For a race event, which constitutes qualifying and mains, only two sets are allowed for the Trap Nats. The number of sets used for practice is however not limited. You are allowed to take a set of your

practice tires and enter them as a set of race tires in which case you will only be allowed to enter one more set of tires as race tires, for a total of two sets per vehicle for both qualifying and mains.

You must use the standard inserts supplied with your tire purchase.

This may be scrutinised during the event.

Details for ordering and pricing will be published in due course.

Stadium trucks and Short Course Trucks are not running a controlled tyre and racers may use any tire.

4.2 APPROVED FREQUENCIES

- ❖ 27 MHz: Only frequencies 26.995, 27.045, 27.095, 27.145, 27.195, and 27.255MHz
- ❖ 2.4GHz DSM/DSS systems

4.3 MARSHALLING

- ❖ Hybrid marshalling system will be used. What this means is the following:
 - Each racer will marshal after his race as per normal
 - In the cases where there are not enough marshals for the next race (due to not enough racers in previous race, or due to drivers racing races directly after one another), a dedicated marshal will fill the gaps
 - Cost – R60 per driver for the weekend

6. REGISTRATION

7. VENUE AMENITIES

- Trap has its own toilets on site
- Food
 - ❖ Trap has its own canteen on site which will be open on Saturday and Sunday.
 - ❖ There are several fast food outlets available in the area.

8. TRACK DETAILS

- The track is made from compacted clay with a track width of between 3 to 3.5 meters. The current length varies from 120 meter to 140 meters depending on the particular layout used. The track includes a new bridge which has been built specifically for the Nats. The entire track is being surfaced in carpet.

9. DRIVERS STAND DETAILS

- The drivers stand can hold up to 15 drivers with an elevated view of the whole track. The stand is no less than 2.2 meters in height and is 15 meters long having its own pit lane 1.6 meter wide

10. TIMING (Provided by SARDA off-road electric)

- Redundant MyLaps RC4 decoder boxes
- Redundant scoring loops
- Bbk Race Management Software

11. PIT AREA AMENITIES

- There are three separate areas for drivers to set up their pits:
 - Space for gazebos behind the drivers stand (bring your own table, chair and gazebo)
 - Space for gazebos in the area between the canteen and the track (bring your own table, chair and gazebo)
 - Fully covered pit area with tables and power which can accommodate 70 competitors under roof (bring your own chair)
- There is sufficient electric power and outlets for all competitors throughout the venue – Please bring extension cords
- **DO NOT FORGET** your ***CAPS, SUNSCREEN and plenty of WATER.***
